Dr. Jahanbegloo is a philosopher and the author of over 25 books in three languages - Persian, French and English. He has taught in several leading academic institutions across the world including the University of Toronto; York University, Toronto; The Centre for the Study of Developing Societies, Delhi; and The Department of Contemporary Studies of the Cultural Research Centre, Tehran.

In 2009, he was awarded the Peace Prize by the United Nations Association in Spain. Dr. Jahanbegloo has a B.A. and M.A. in Philosophy, History and Political Science and a Ph.D. in Philosophy from the Sorbonne University. He was also a post-doctoral fellow at Harvard University.
