Professor (Dr.) C. Raj Kumar was appointed as the Founding Vice Chancellor of O.P. Jindal Global University in India at the age of 34. Professor Kumar has academic qualifications from the University of Oxford, Harvard University, University of Hong Kong, University of Delhi and Loyola College. He was a Rhodes Scholar at the University of Oxford, UK, where he obtained his Bachelor of Civil Law (B.C.L.) degree; a London Gammon Fellow at the Harvard Law School, USA, where he obtained his Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree and a James Souverine Gallo Memorial Scholar at the Harvard University. He was awarded the Doctor of Legal Science

(S.J.D.) by the University of Hong Kong. He also obtained a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) degree from the University of Delhi, India; and a Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) degree from the Loyola College of the University of Madras, India.



Mr. Ansuman Pattnaik is presently posted as the Additional Director General in the Competition Commission of India. He is an officer of the Indian Revenue Service (Income Tax) of 1994 batch. He has served in various responsible positions in different capacities including policy making assignment with the central government. He has been a decorated scholar and stood First Class First in M.Sc. (Physics) program and was among the top two students in MA in Public Policy & Sustainable Development program. He was a part of the Hubert H Humphrey Fellow programme at Michigan State University, U.S., and the Emerging Leaders Fellow

at Australia India Institute, University of Melbourne, Australia. He has previously been involved in intelligence, investigation & enforcement, and policy formulations on direct tax, finance, and budgeting during his tenure under different departments of the Government of India, like the Ministry of Finance, Income Tax Department, and Department of Revenue. He also formulated policies on I&B, Broadcasting Administration, under the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting. Along with that he has participated in various workshops regarding combating cartels and abuse of dominance, leadership & change management and GATT related issues.



Ms. Anne MacGregor is a National Partner in the Antitrust/Competition group in Dechert LLP's Brussels office. She has more than two decades of broad-based EU legal experience in the competition, trade and regulatory fields in the Brussels arena. She is recognised in the 2016 Chambers Global and Chambers Europe Guides to the World's Leading Business Lawyers, with clients describing her as "perceptive, incisive and politically astute". In 2016 she was featured in the fifth edition of Global Competition Review's Women in Antitrust. On the competition law front, EU and multi-jurisdictional merger control in global transactions are Anne's forte. She

has in-depth experience in advising corporations on antitrust clearances that will be required around the world in any given transaction, and expertise in the preparation of such merger control notifications and associated advocacy work required to shepherd them successfully through the relevant competition authorities. Anne was born and grew up in Canberra, and has a B.A./LLB. (Hons) from the Australian National University. She left Australia in 1991 on a German government scholarship and studied at the University of Hamburg for two years where she completed an LL.M., before a traineeship with the European Commission took her to Brussels in 1993. Following seven years in private practice in Brussels, she spent over a year in Washington DC as a trade lawyer in 2000-2001 before returning to Brussels and focusing on competition law. Anne is admitted to practice in NSW and the ACT in Australia, England & Wales, New York, Brussels (as a foreign lawyer), and Ireland.



Mr. Dhanendra Kumar is the first Chairperson of Competition Commission of India (Feb 2009 - June 2011) when the enforcement of Competition Law was initiated. He was responsible for developing in the initial stages the roll out of enforcement and M&A Regulations, put in place the systems, recruit professionals and capacity building. Post June 2011, he chaired the Committee to draft National Competition Policy, and suggest amendments in the Act. He also chaired the Committee for Reforms in Housing and Real Estate Sector. Earlier, he was India's Executive Director at the World Bank/IFC at Washington DC. He is a veteran IAS officer, with

four decades of national, state and global experience, having served as Secretary in several key Ministries, including Defense Production, Roads and Highways and Culture. He worked as Additional Secretary in the Ministry of Telecom (1998-2002) when migration of cellular telephony took place, BSNL was carved out, and reconstituted TRAI was set-up. He also worked as Principal Secretary to CM, Haryana (1991-1996) when a big push was given to industrialization and infrastructure development including Udyog Vihar, Manesar etc. He is the founder Chairman of Competition Advisory Services (I) LLP, a niche consultancy and advisory service in Competition Law (www.compad.in) and facilitating investments in India, advising several MNCs and prominent Law firms. He is currently also assisting Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (of Ministry of Corporate Affairs) as Honorary Principal Advisor and Chief Mentor of School of Competition Law and Market Regulation. Widely regarded as a global expert in Competition, Regulatory reforms and Public Policy, he is frequently invited to speak at various forums in India and abroad.
