Global Library

An area of approximately 20,000 square feet has been provided for the development of the library in the T-2 block of the academic building in the campus. The library has a collection of about 45,000 print volumes and an array of electronic resources. The print collection includes books, monographs, research reports, law reports and back volumes of periodicals, among other study material. In addition to professional reading material, the library offers a large collection of leisure reading and books for the development of soft skills. The print resources of the library are divided into ‘General Collection’ and ‘Reference Collection’.

WHAT THE LATEST HUMAN CAPITAL REPORT MEANS FOR INDIA

Introduction

The recently published Human Capital Report (HCR) by the World Economic Forum reflects how different countries are "developing" and "deploying" their human capital stocks. This is important not only to understand how an economy is progressing but also to infer its growth potential so that policies can be adopted accordingly. As per the HCR, although the education related indicators in India have improved significantly, but only 57.7% of the total talent is actually being utilised. Unutilised human capital reduces returns to human capital investment thereby giving negative signals to future human capital investments. In this context, this article aims to discuss India's position in the HCR and identifies a commonly overlooked area of improvement for its human capital accumulation.

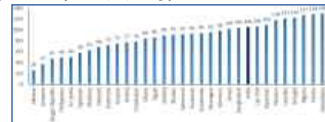
The need to study human capital emerged in the 1980s when the neoclassical growth theories appeared insufficient to explain the process of long-run economic growth without assuming the role of exogenous factors. Endogenous growth theory overcame this by broadening the concept of capital to include both physical and human capital. Human capital underlies the productivity level in an economy. It incorporates factors such as, education, health, training, work experience, skills or migration of individuals. It has not only evolved as an input in the domestic production function but also as an important factor for attracting foreign investments and increasing international trade.

The Human Capital Report (HCR)

The HCR, introduced in 2013, tries to estimate human capital in different countries. It covers 46 indicators related to human capital formation in the form of education, skill formation, health, labour participation and so on. These are grouped under two "pillars" - learning and employment - and are calculated separately for each country. HCR uses disaggregated level of indicators relevant for various age groups. Indicators for each age group is given a different weight while constructing the index. Pillar weightage for the indicators corresponding to the age group of 25-54 years is 41% while it is 58% for the group aged above 65.

High income countries such as Finland, Norway, Switzerland, Japan and Sweden occupy the top ranks in the HCR 2016. This reiterates the positive association between income, education, health and human capital augmentation. However, it is worth noting, that such a causal relation can run in the other direction also. Unless a country has enough resources to invest in health, education or skill formation, human capital will be low and the country will remain trapped in a low-level equilibrium. This partly justifies the low ranking of the developing countries in the HCR. Figure 1 shows the relative ranking of the lower middle income group of countries (LMICs) as per the HCR 2016. While 5 LMICs rank within top 20, there are 21 LMICs ranking within 100. India's rank is 102 out of the sample of the 130 countries studied in the HCR 2016.

Based on eight performance indicators, namely academic reputation, employer reputation, proportion of staff with a PhD, faculty / student

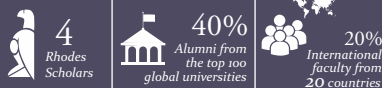
